MISSION AND ROLE

Conscious of what is at stake and of the importance to reduce our impact on the environment, the 20 municipalities of the MRC des Laurentides unanimously resolved to join forces to ensure a better a management of residual materials that is more respectful of the environment and of the human health.

The MRC des Laurentides was entrusted with the residual materials management on its whole territory. Therefore, it drew up its residual materials management program (PGMR) which came into effect in August 2004, in order to meet the requirements of the Quebec Residual Materials Management Policy 1998-2008. The nation wide goal is to reclaim more than 65% of the residual material generated each year. For the moment the MRC is targeting on household residual materials but in a near future, it will also have to manage residual material originating from industrial, commercial and institutional establishments.

Starting July 1<sup>st</sup> 2007, various changes will affect the collection of residual materials on the territory of the MRC des Laurentides. By consulting this website, you will be able to get the information pertaining to the collection of household waste, of recyclable matters and of large items in your municipality.

Furthermore, additional information is also available regarding household hazardous waste such as paints, oils, batteries, etc. as well as disposal sites for dry material.

We are counting on your collaboration so that every move will allow us to go a longer way and thus reduce our impact on the environment.
