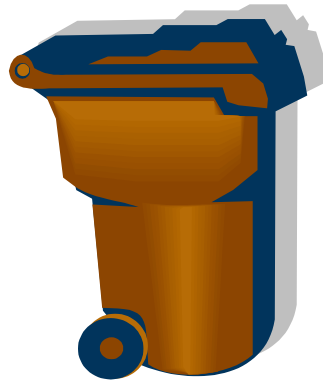


COLLECTION OF HOUSEHOLD WASTE



Here are the instructions to follow for the use of the bins:

- 1) All solid waste must be placed in the black bins. Solid waste placed outside the black bins will not be collected.
- 2) All recyclable matters must be placed in the green bins.
- 3) Do not set your bins in front of your mail box.
- 4) Align the bins with the handles facing the road to facilitate the pick up.
- 5) Take the bins to the road the day preceding the collection.
- 6) Once emptied, the bins must be put back near the residence or at the place reserved for them.
- 7) During winter, your bins must be clear of ice and snow.
- 8) It is important to clean the inside of your bins from time to time using a water spray.
- 9) Material from construction and demolition are not solid waste nor are recyclable matters same as used oils, old batteries and paint. Specific places are available to dispose of those matters. Visit the Website of the MRC to learn more: www.mrclaurentides.qc.ca.
- 10) Do not forget that the bins belong to the municipality. If you move, you must leave them with the property.
- 11) You will receive, every year, a calendar of the collection days applicable in your municipality. Look for the next calendar; it will be **distributed** in June of every year.
