## Not to be disposed

PAPER & CARDBOARD



- Paper, envelopes, paper bags
- Newspapers, flyers, magazines
- Boxes and cardboard boxes
- Milk, cream or juice cartons
- Phone books
- Books without covers or bindings

- Do not tie up paper
- Do not leave paper in plastic bags (ex. publisac)
- Fold boxes
- Empty boxes of their wrappings (ex. bag or plastic wrappings)

- Soiled, waxed, plastified or metallic paper
- Diapers, tissues, paper towels
- Wallpaper, stickers, carbon paper, photos


PLASTIC



- Any container or plastic cover that has one of the above recycling symbols:



- Rinse all containers to avoid odors in the bin
- Do not put containers in plastic bags

- Any container or plastic cover that has one of the following recycling symbols: 
- All bags and plastic films
- All containers and lids that do not have the recycling symbol:
- Toys, tools, lighters, disposable razors, bags, rulers, carpets, etc.

METAL



- Tin cans or covers
- Cans (juice, soft drinks, etc.)
- Plates and aluminum paper

- Rinse all containers to avoid odors in the bin
- It is not necessary to remove labels but they will be recycled if taken off the cans

- Car batteries, batteries, propane tanks, aerosol cans, paint, RDD
- Chocolate and granola bar wrappings, chip bags

GLASS



- All glass bottles and containers, whatever the color

- Rinse all containers to avoid odors in the bin
- Recycle lids but throw away corks

- Glass (windows), drinking glasses, cups, mirrors, bulbs, neons, dishes, ceramics, pottery, pyrex
