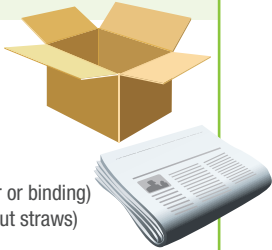
GREEN BIN

RECYCLABLE MATERIALS



CLEAN PAPER AND CARDBOARD

- Newspapers, magazines and flyers
- Paper sheets and envelopes
- Paper bags
- Cardboard boxes and packaging
- Directories and books (without cover or binding)
- Milk, cream and juice cartons (without straws)



PLASTICS

- All containers and lids with numbers:
- All bags, flexible packaging and plastic films (group together in a transparent bag and tie well)



METAL

- Tins
- Cans
- Aluminum plates
- Coat hangers (group in bundles)
- Pipes and pots



GLASS

- All glass bottles and containers, in any color



REFUSED MATERIALS

- Soiled paper or cardboard
- Plastics without a number or with number
- Toys
- Paint cans
- Propane tanks, aerosols and fire extinguishers
- Tools
- Windows, mirrors, light bulbs and Pyrex glass
- Food scraps
- Leaves and yard waste
- Etc.

BLACK BIN



REFUSED MATERIALS

It is prohibited to put the following materials in the black bin:

- Medicines and biomedical wastes
- Recyclable materials (e.g., paper and cardboard, plastic containers, glass and metal)
- Household hazardous material (e.g., paints, batteries, oils, pesticides, propane bottles)
- Construction and demolition materials (wood, gypsum board...)
- Electrical, electronic appliances and computers
- Yard waste and leaves (e.g. dead leaves, grass clippings and Christmas trees)
- Tires and car batteries
- Furniture and mattresses

ORGANIC WASTE

ORGANIC WASTE ACCEPTED (LOOSE OR IN PAPER BAGS ONLY)



FOOD WASTE

including fresh, frozen, dried, cooked and prepared food as well as table scraps (cooked, raw, spoiled)

- Fruits and vegetables; pasta, bread and cereal, flour, sugar
- Dairy products, sweets and candy, coffee (beans, grounds and filters) and tea bags
- Crab and lobster shells, egg shells, nut shells
- Meat, fish, bones and animal food



SOILED PAPER AND CARDBOARD

- Soiled paper plates or cups; Cardboard soiled by food (pizza, etc.)
- Soiled paper towels; Soiled facial tissues and paper napkins



GREEN WASTE

- Dead leaves, garden waste: flowers, plants, evergreen needles, hedge cuttings and weeds (except from exotic and invasive plants)
- Lawn clippings, sawdust, bark, wood chips; indoor plants



OTHER MATERIAL

- Cold ashes – after 4 week; tobacco and cigarette paper
- Hair, animal hair and fur; litter from small animals (cats, rabbits, hamsters)



REFUSED MATERIALS

- Biodegradable or compostable plastic bags do not go into the wheeled brown bin
- Household hazardous waste (oils, paints, batteries, pesticides, fertilizers); Tires
- Recyclable materials (clean paper and cardboard; glass, plastic and metal containers)
- Construction materials, window glass, glass and metal; carpets
- Diapers, sanitary products (tampons, sanitary pads); medication, waxed paper, dental floss, wax and chewing gum
- Vacuum bags and their contents, dryer lint and dryer sheets
- Disposable dusting sheets (such as Swiffer); dead animals
- Textiles (including clothing made of organic materials)
- Invasive exotic plants (Giant hogweed, Japanese knotweed, Ditch weed, Purple loosestrife); Rocks, pebbles and stones; corks

RULES TO BE FOLLOWED

Brown, green or black bins containing **REFUSED MATERIALS will not be emptied** and material outside the bins **will not be picked up**.

Only your extra **RECYCLABLE MATERIAL** can be brought to the Ecocentre.

ADVICE

- The black bin should be considered as last option.
- The weight of materials placed in the black bin determines the bill to be paid for landfill.
- The heavier it is, the higher the collective bill!

WHEN

Place the bins at the roadside the evening before collection and remove after the collection is complete.

HOW TO PLACE YOUR BINS

Recycling and waste bins must be placed side by side, **with a minimum space of 60 cm around each bin.**

HANDLES AND WHEELS MUST POINT TOWARDS THE HOUSE so that nothing prevents access for mechanized arm.

LEAVES DISPOSAL

Bring your bags of leaves to the Municipal Garage between October 8 and 14 2018.

IN WINTER

Completely remove snow and ice from top and sides of bins so that they are easily accessible. **Bins that are covered with snow or hard to reach will not be emptied.**

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)*

Paint, aerosols, varnishes, solvents, pesticides, cleaning products, engine oil, compact fluorescent light bulbs, fluorescent tubes, propane bottles, batteries, ink cartridges, fire extinguishers, etc.

*These products can also be brought to any municipal HHW depot.



CONSTRUCTION, RENOVATION, DEMOLITION MATERIALS

Wood, branches, Christmas trees, metal, concrete, asphalt shingles, bricks, stone, gypsum, floor coverings (carpet, linoleum, ceramic, etc.), showers, baths, sinks, toilets, etc.



ELECTRICAL, ELECTRONIC, TECHNOLOGY DEVICES

Appliances with halocarbons (refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and dehumidifiers), stoves, dishwashers, washing machines, dryers, small and electrical appliances, televisions, videos, radios, computers, peripherals, cell phones.



FURNITURES

All furnitures (sofas, mattresses, tables, chairs, etc.)



MISCELLANEOUS OBJECTS

BBQ, lawn mowers, pool covers, swings, etc.



GREEN WASTES

ACCEPTED ONLY AT MONT-TREMBLANT AND SAINTE-AGATHE-DES-MONTS ECOCENTRES, DURING SPRING AND FALL PERIOD OR YEAR ROUND AT RÉGIE INTERMUNICIPALE DES DÉCHETS DE LA ROUGE (RIDR).

Dead leaves, grass, stems and twigs.



RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

Paper, cardboard, glass, plastic and metal containers.



TIRES AND CAR BATTERIES

All car and truck tires, without rims, and car batteries.

INSTRUCTIONS

Residential service only. Any business will be refused. Proof of residence required.

APPLIANCES WITHOUT HALOCARBONS

Stove, dishwasher, washing machine, dryer, water heater.

Other materials must be brought to the ecocentre (see *ecocentre* box).
